Claremont recognises that all our activities have an impact on the environment, from our activities to our working practices and business relationships. All staff, interns, volunteers, members, clients, hall hirers and tenants have a responsibility to reduce these environmental impacts.

Claremont commits to ensure compliance with all relevant environmental legislation, to continually improve our environmental performance and to prevent pollution across all our activities, products and services.

In particular we shall:

- Identify, manage and monitor our environmental performance
- Minimise our consumption of office paper and reuse or recycle materials wherever possible

- Informing all contractors and sub-contractors of the requirement to comply with this policy when providing goods and services
- Reviewing this policy and our environmental performance on an annual basis
